A history of Nantes



*Around 1830, the first soap-factories set up in Nantes.
During the ninetieth century there were about 30 soap-factories in Nantes.*



Savonnerie de l'Atlantique is part of this heritage and remains the only industrial capacity in France implementing the so-called « Marseille method ».

Few dates



- 1915 *Savonnerie Nantaise 7 quai Ferdinand Favre in Nantes*
- 1941 *The factory is bought by Mr Clair BERNARD*
- 1944 *The factory is totally destroyed by bombing*
- 1947 *A new factory is rebuilt in Rezé*
- April 2005 *Bankruptcy of Savonnerie et Parfumerie Bernard*
- Feb 1, 2006 *Transfert of the assets to Savonnerie de l'Atlantique. Restart of business with Private Label business (22 workers and 4 customers). Refocusing on the core business : soap and only soap.*
- 2016 *Opening of a 2nd industrial site near Nantes*
